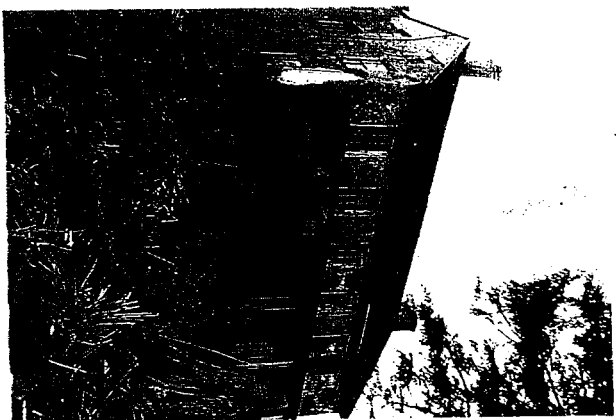

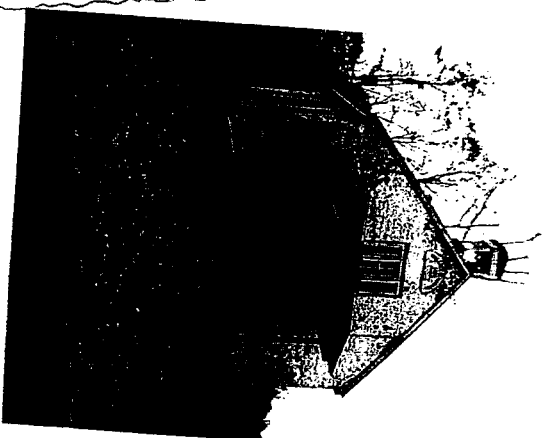

Home of Edward Hunter born 22nd of June, 1793. (My great-grandfather) Located near Glen Moore, Pa. The Wallace Seminary was built on a little hill on a corner of this farm.



This seminary still stands, a little oge room, country schoolhouse, among a pretty grove of trees. The name and date are still visible above the door. It was here that Edward first met the ~~Mormons~~ and the Prophet Joseph Smith.
