There is only one item of news for this letter. The CANNON FAMILY CENTENNIAL REUNION will be held on July 25 (Friday) in the Garden Park Ward Amusement Hall, 1150 Yale Avenue, Salt Lake City, Utah. This should be the best and most enjoyable reunion the Family has ever held. There will be a visiting and "get acquainted" period from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., relics and old-time pictures will be on display. Dinner will be served from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. A meeting will follow the dinner--a short part of which will be devoted to business of the association. After the business has been disposed of, a program will take up the remainder of the evening.

No set charge is being made for this event nor for the brochure enclosed. Cost of the dinner to the association is one (\$1.00) dollar per plate. Experience of the past proves conclusively that members of the Family can be relied upon to give generously for Family functions and expenses. Reservations and contributions should be mailed to the Family Treasurer, Edwin Q. Cannon, in the enclosed envelope. At the Reunion there will be members of our Finance Committee available to receipt for all donations made at that time.

The publishing of this historical booklet, genealogical research and the cost of microfilm records from the Isle of Man have involved the association in

considerable expense this year. And the Reunion dinner, of course, is an added item of cost to be paid for.

Your attendance at the Reunion, however, is more important than the size of the contribution you make. Come with all your family, enjoy a good time, and make or renew your acquaintance with other branches of the family.
