Our stomachs are still churning. We just finished another round of missionary sone conferences. They are fun and we enjoy meeting with all our missionaries, but it is very tireing and by the end of the three days we have had it. My tail bone is so sore, even thought I carry a pillow around with me. Sunday, we left early and went to Wiesbaden to Pristhood, then went to Mainz to Sunday School back to W. for Sacrament meeting. We had a nice relaxing dinner at the American Officers Club, came home and attended two Sessions of General Conference, one in German and one in English.

Today Kathie isn't teaching so we are going shopping in a little while. Evelyn dear I didn't get a birthday letter off to you and I am sorry. We thought of you and hoped you had a very happy day. We hope you received your gift and that it was all in one piece. To get to your questions-- We have been in a 707 plane, but just to see it. They are the biggest things I have ever seen. I think we will go home in one. The missionaries think they are the GREATEST. Kathie's colors are pink and white- the girls in a lighter pink and me in a darker shade. Your white linen dress sounds fine. If you want a new dress pink or what ever you can find will be fine. We would like very much for you to take care of the dinning room, OK? I am sure your white dress would be lovely and not to summery. Max will be fine in his suit, but be sure he brings his PAANTS to go with it OK?? HA HA. We are having the wedding breakfast at a very nice hotel in Bern. We expect about 20 people. So many of Kathie's friends are going to Switzerland for the marriage, so we want to have them come to the breakfast. A suit or dress with coat will be fine. We are hopping it will be nice weather, but then again it may be raining. I will take care of reservations in Holland. Will Tuesday and Wed nights May 11, and 12th be OK? Wif said he didn't think you would want to spend any more time there or you wouldn't have as much time as you would like in London and Paris. We received a letter from Michael the other day and he ask if you would be in New York. Am sure he would be thrilled if you were able to visit for awhile. The train service here in Euppe is very good, fast and comfortable. We have been on several trips by train and have enjoyed them very much. You get to see so much more that way. When you arrive at the Frankfurt airport, dont be nervous just follow the crouds. The plane lands quite a ways from the buildings so they bus you in, then you have to go through customs before you come through the door where we will be standing with smileing faces. Remember you will have to start speaking German as soon as you get off the plane, as you will be on GERMAN soil.
