Evie Dear: I have looked thru my files & have come up with this recipe for Vanilla Ice cream. It sounds like the one I have used, hope it works.

French Vanilla Ice Cream.

Beat 7 egg yolks in a bowl, slowly add $1\frac{1}{2}$ C. sugar & 1 Qt. thin cream. Cook in double boiler, stirring constantly with wooden spoon until custard coats the spoon. When nearly cold, strain into freezer, add ~~PRRP~~ vanilla to taste. (It suggests 2 TB. of Vanilla, but I think you had better add to taste). Beat whites until stiff, add $\frac{1}{2}$ C. sugar. Add to cream just before freezing. French Vanilla uses more eggs.

I've never made this recipe, but it sounds good.
