Just a few lines to let you know how things are here. I have been rather busy this week. My "government" job is proving rather interesting. I have been assigned to a project of unit cost analysis for the purpose of providing the estimating and planning group some definite unit cost figures on the various activities involved in the construction jobs. The past week I have been preparing various forms for use on current jobs to compile the necessary data. If the work paid a little more salary I would like to keep it, but it is not enough to live on alone, so I must use it only as a temporary measure.
