remember him in our Prairs and hope the
Lord will Bless him and restore and
o that every thing will ^{be} right again with him
we have Faith it will we often think of
You and would like to help You but we
have no prices on our crops nothing to fetch
any money into the home buty plenty to
eat and feed our stock and work from
morning till night I am getting sick of my
job no chance to sell pigs or horn stock or
Farm Hoping things may chaign befor long
it is late will close Hoping the Lord will
and ^{Bless} comfort and Prosper You in the Prair
of Your Father and Mother dont forget
