She died 1 Dec 1926 in Minersville, Beaver, Utah and was buried 4 Dec 1926 in Minersville, Beaver, Utah. She married Franklin D. WILLIAMS (David Edward WILLIAMS, Margaret REESE) 27 Oct 1909 in Salt Lake, Salt Lake, Utah. He was born 26 Jan 1888 in Greenville, Beaver, Utah. He died 22 Jun 1956 in Milford, Beaver, Utah and was buried 25 Jun 1956 in Minersville, Beaver, Utah.

Leah Hannah Marshall was born while her father, George Marshall, was on a mission in England. She was a beautiful baby and her family was so happy to have a baby girl. She was the seventh child in the family. She had lots of black hair and big hazel eyes. She was the pride and joy of her father.

The family sent him a picture of her and her mother, also a picture of four babies the same age. Her father was able to pick out his own little girl from among the four babies.

Leah's father, George Marshall, ran a store in Minersville and they had the post office in the store. Leah worked in the store when she was fourteen years old and did the ordering. She was a person that made friends

easily and everyone loved her.

She went to the Murdock Academy for two years.

She spent some time in Provo at the B.Y.U. She wrote a letter to her brother, Elmer, in 1907 from B.Y.U. telling about school. (Following is part of the letter:) "Cassie, Gertie, and Retta went home Monday. They say they are going to quit school. To bad Minersville girls can't act a little white. A.B. said he

was getting tired of their fooling. Well, he caught a crowd of us girls playing cards the other night. He said he didn't want to catch us again or it would be all day with us. I didn't know how to play cards when I came here but I am learning bad habits."

Leah was a beautiful seamstress. She made a lady's suit. A salesman from Z.C.M.I. saw it and took it to Salt Lake, where it was in the store window for a while. When she went to Salt Lake to get the suit they offered her a job in the store, so she stayed and worked during the summer.

When she returned home, she met a handsome young man named Frank Williams. He had a herd of sheep out west of Minersville. He would ride his horse in at night to see her. The following winter he was called on a mission to England. He gave her a ring and asked her to wait for him. Frank had only been on his mission for 17 months when Leah received a telegram from Frank asking her to meet him in Salt Lake the next day. Frank's brother, Griff, also on a mission, had died while in England. The mission president sent Frank home with his brother's body. Griff was buried in Idaho. While in Idaho, Leah and Frank decided to get married in Salt Lake on the way home. They were married in the Salt Lake Temple October 27, 1909.

(Following is an excerpt from a letter written by Leah's mother, Rachel:) "Oh, have you heard Frank's brother, Griff, died in England and Frank was released to bring the body home. Leah met him two weeks ago with all the Williams family in Ogden. They went on to Idaho where they buried Griff. Leah wrote home for a recommend. They, I guess, go through the temple today. It was awfully sudden, near made us sick for we were not prepared for it at all. They will be home in a few days."

(Following is a letter Leah wrote to her brother, Elmer, soon after her marriage:) November 21, 1909. Tonight is Sunday night and I didn't go to meeting so will spend my time writing to you. This is the first letter I have written to you since I changed my name to Mrs. Williams. I guess you have heard about us being married before now. It was awfully surprising to hear of Frank coming home so soon. But it was none too soon for me, but of course, I didn't want him to come home the way he did. It was certainly a sad affair bringing his brother home dead. We can't tell what will happen.

I went to Salt Lake and met him when he came home. So we thought we just as well get married and be done with it for that is what we certainly would have done in a short time. Frank would have liked to of finished his mission but hope he can go again sometime and finish it. He has certainly improved lots since he has been gone

and I tell you I am proud of him.

We are living in Punkintown in that place Earl and Sade used to have. George Williams has been living there but he is moving back to Greenville. So we have quite a nice little home for a beginning. Frank is taking care of the sheep this winter so won't be home much but I can run up and stay with Ma when he isn't home.

Just think the 4th of December I will be 20 years old. Gee, that sounds awful old to me, so don't think you are the only one getting old. I hate to get out of my teens, would always like to be a little girl.

Since I quit the store, George has Vella in my place. They have Eva Stoddard tending the kids and keeping house, so they won't miss me much.

Frank is out to the herd tonight so he can't write, will write next time. The kids send love and kisses. Goldie and Truman say they can't wait for Elmer to come home.

I am as ever your loving sister, Leah

Leah and Frank had eight children: Viola, Spence, Max, Margaret, John, Deloss, Naomi, and Renee. Naomi and Deloss passed away when they were two years old.

Leah was very talented. She was a wonderful mother. She took part in many plays. She played the piano for Church, Sunday School and Primary. She was a good singer. Rachel Eyre said, "If you wanted to have a good time, just go visit Aunt Leah. You could have a good laugh and a good time while you were doing the work. She made everything fun."

Leah passed away at the age of 37 on December 1, 1926 leaving six children ranging in age ten months to sixteen years.

After Leah had passed away, John, who was four years old, got sick. The doctors didn't know what was wrong with him. They sent him to Salt Lake to the L.D.S. Hospital where Lucy Pocock was the head nurse. A nurse

told Frank he would have to leave the room because he was not allowed to stay with John. Frank said, "There is

no way I am leaving." They called the head nurse, Lucy. After she heard Frank's story, she had them bring a bed in the room for Frank.

Frank had to go home to attend to his other children and his business. Lucy and Rachel Williams McKnight were left to care for John. Lucy spent a lot of time with John. John loved Lucy and she loved him. When it was time for him to go home, he didn't want to leave Lucy. Frank, also, had a spot in his heart for Lucy. He courted her by mail and went to see her as often as he could. They fell in love and were married July 14, 1927 in the Salt Lake Temple.

FUNERAL SERVICES FOR MRS. FRANK WILLIAMS (LEAH MARSHALL WILLIAMS)

Impressive and beautiful were the funeral services held Saturday, December 4, 1926 for Mrs. Leah Marshall Williams, beloved wife of Frank D. Williams, at the Minersville ward chapel. Hundreds of friends and relatives from Idaho, Salt Lake, Provo, and from every corner of Beaver County, pushed their way into the overcrowded church, far too small to hold all who came to pay their last respects to their dearly beloved friend and neighbor. With a cold wind stinging their faces, hundreds stood outside who were unable to gain access to the building.

Bishop George H. Eyre conducted the services. The Minersville choir sang, "Sometime We'll Understand." Elder Joseph Banks offered the opening prayer. "Rock of Ages," was sung by a male quartet.

Elder Lou Griffiths of Salt Lake City, was the first speaker. He said love and sympathy brought him there; that love, kindness, and sincerity radiated from the home of the grieving family. The life of the deceased was compared to the beauty and purity of the immense floral offerings.

Other speakers were President T.W. Gunn, Bishop Eyre, Dr. Charles R. Parrish, and former Stake President J.F. Tolton, all of whom eulogized the exemplary life of Mrs. Leah Williams, who had been called in the bloom of her life, a mother and wife whose place cannot be filled.

The choir rendered, "Cast Thy Bread Upon the Water," with solo work by Lydia Robins and Mrs. Banks, during the service.

The closing song, "Nearer My God to Thee," was sung by the choir. The benediction was pronounced by Elder Henry F. Baker.

Between fifty and seventy-five cars followed the hearse and mourners to the cemetery, where the grave was dedicated by Bishop John R. Williams, of Black Foot, Idaho.

But I managed one once in awhile.*

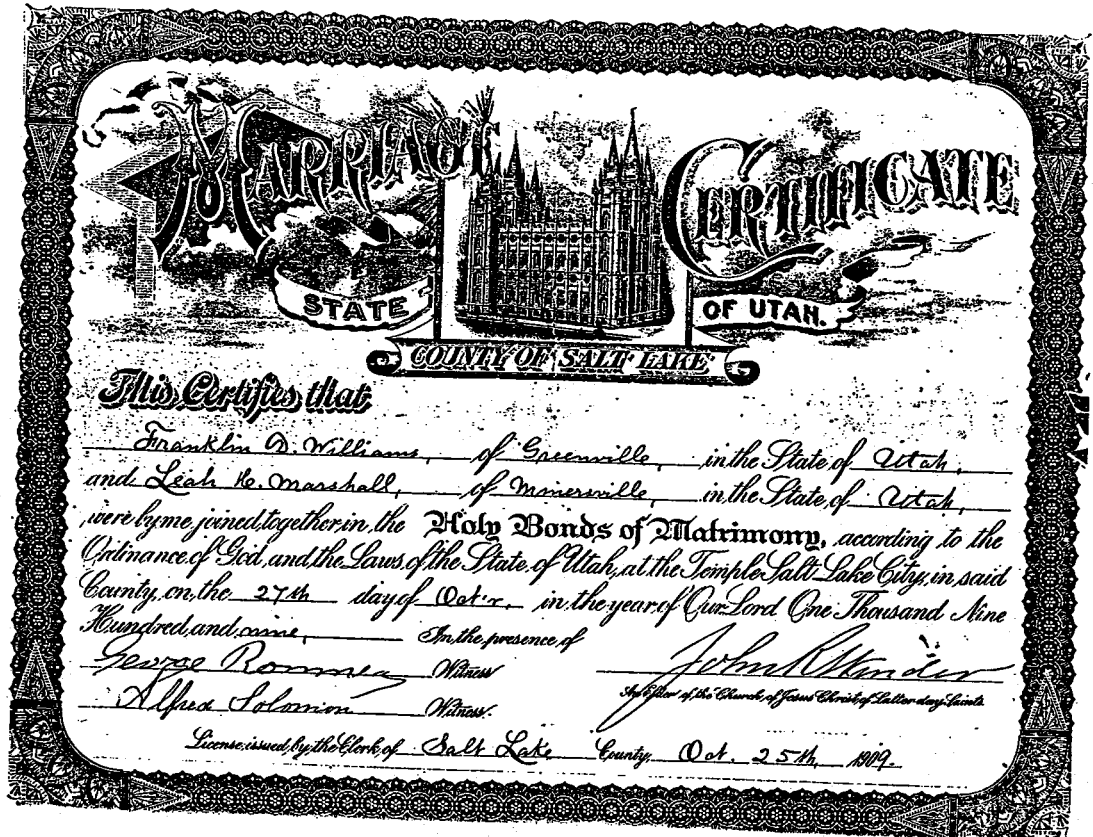
*Daddy laughed yesterday,

FRANKLIN D WILLIAMS (1888-1956)

Franklin D Williams was born January 26, 1888 at Greenville. He attended elementary school in Greenville. At the tender age of twelve, his father died, leaving many responsibilities upon those who were left at home.

His schooling was limited but not his education. As a young man he served a mission for the L.D.S. Church in Great Britain. While he was on his mission, his brother, Griffith, was also in Great Britain on a mission. Griffith was taken to the hospital with a ruptured appendix. Surgery proved fatal, as Griffith passed away a few days later. This necessitated Frank's release to bring his brother's body home, thus bringing Frank's mission to a close at 17 months.

After his release from the mission field and his arrival in Salt Lake City on October 28, 1909, he married Leah Marshall in the Salt Lake Temple. They made their home in Minersville. Frank became interested in the sheep business and proved himself a successful farmer. They were both active in church organization and civic affairs.

Frank was Stake Superintendent of the Sunday School and was honored to be on the High Council of the Beaver Stake. He was an outstanding speaker in the

Church and an inspiration to many. He has the credit of speaking 1,112 funeral sermons. At the time of his death he was a High Priest and a Ward Teacher.

Frank served as Town Board President eight years and Beaver County Chairman of the Republican Party six years. In 1939, he was elected State Senator, representing Beaver and Millard Counties, serving one term of four years. He was director of the State Woolgrowers Association; chairman of the first Advisory Board of Directors of the Division of Grazing, and at the time of his death he was president of the Yellow Mountain Land and Irrigation Company, trustee of the Rocky Ford Irrigation Company and a member of the board of the Minersville Land and Irrigation Company.

He and his wife were blessed with eight lovely children, of whom two passed away in infancy. Naomi died of influenza, and Deloss was drowned in the corral watering trough. Two grown sons also passed away. Spence was killed in a mine explosion at the age of 28. Max was killed with lightning at the age of 34.

On December 1, 1926, his wife passed away, leaving six children. Sickness and sorrow never came singly, as Frank's children were afflicted with pneumonia, measles and whooping cough throughout the entire winter. The

father, dearly loved by his family. Frank loved people. He was a charitable person, what he had he shared with others. It was very common to see him taking sacks of groceries to needy people. He loved children. He was noted for always kissing all the babies. Sometimes he would have to take his hanky out of his pocket and wipe their nose first, then say, "My, you are a sweet little child." He loved family gatherings. He wanted his children around him as much as possible. He made the rounds to each one of his children's homes each morning to make sure they made it through the night. Frank had the first car in Minersville, the first telephone, and the first bathroom.

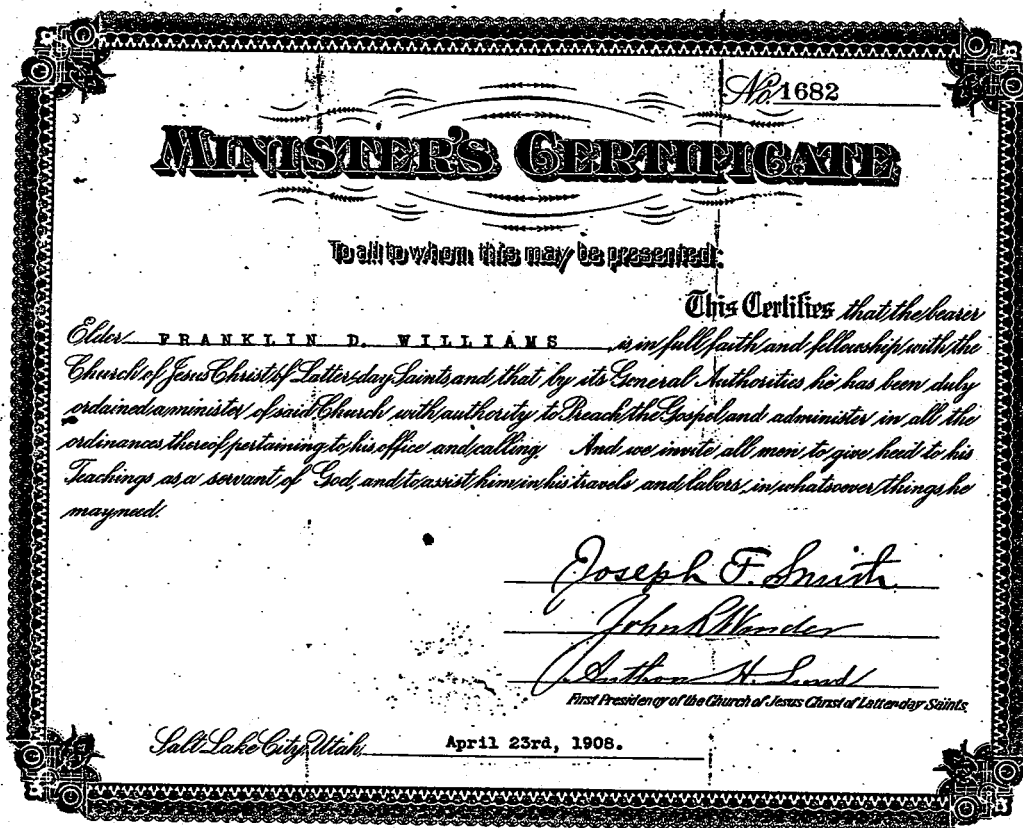
